We require a minimum of 30 participants to ensure this goes ahead, so we are offering an EARLYBIRD registration and payment.

CONDITIONS

Operator: Adelaide Skydiving. www.adelaideskydiving.com.au

Experience:

Tandem jump from 10,000 feet. Thirty seconds of freefall (note an error on the poster lists this as 60 seconds which is incorrect) followed by approx. 5 minutes of parachute fall.

Max per flight – 2 or 3 (subject to plane availability). Max weight to skydive: 110kgs

Prepayment Conditions:

All monies will be held by the CPRBTA in escrow until such time that the minimum number of 30 is reached. If the Festival fails to meet the minimum numbers by 31 March 2022, then payment will be REFUNDED IN FULL by the CPRBTA as soon as possible after cancellation of the event is confirmed.

Public Liability:

Adelaide Skydiving hold a \$20 million public liability policy. This can be viewed on application.

Covid Requirements:

All health directives at the time will be followed. Based on current directives, the following conditions apply. These may be altered without notice:

- No vaccination mandate is in place. Everyone welcome.
- Minimum age – 16 years. Maximum weight limit - 110kg
- Masks to be worn in close contact settings as directed by Adelaide Skydiving
- Individuals who have Covid or are considered close contacts of a positive Covid case at the scheduled time of flight, must notify the CPRBTA and Adelaide Skydiving as soon as possible, and cancel. All efforts will be made to refund the affected participant in full as quickly as possible.

- In the case of numerous Covid cases/close contacts who have to cancel their booking (ie over 20), Adelaide Skydiving will make every effort to reschedule as soon as possible. Ideally, this will be evaluated a couple of days prior to the event.

Rain: In the case of rain, the operator still expects to be able to continue between showers or reschedule flights. Weather forecasts will be monitored in the day's prior.

Cancellations: Any cancellation of the entire experience or event for any reason by the organisers or the operator will result in a refund in full.

Contingencies: In the case of an oversubscription, or a delay caused by rain, Monday 20th and Tuesday 21st will be contingency days. Landing location will be moved to the Town Oval.
